Rules regarding enrollment, to be followed while sanctioning division in Non-government Arts, Commerce and Science Colleges

Introduction: - The state is educationally progressing and every year new colleges are being opened and new divisions are being approved. Initially, the sanctioning of additional division was the matter of the university, but as it is related to the grants, the government issued letter Education to the universities regarding sanction of additional divisions in Non-government Arts, Commerce and Science Colleges. The Service Scheme Department No. UMF-1082/126035/ [6935]/ Vishi-2' dated 28th November 1984 and gave directives are as follow:-

- 1] The number of students aspiring for admission should be 40% more than the capacity. [For example, if the admission capacity is 100 and 140 students are aspiring for admission, then the second division can be approved.]
- 2] Once the additional division is started, the additional teachers should be appointed considering the workload.
- 3] The infrastructure/ facilities necessary for the additional division should be available with the college.
- 4] The maximum capacity for admission to the faculty (Arts, Commerce, Science) where the college is located, urban-rural, should not be exhausted.

The government circular, Higher and Technical Education and Service Scheme Department No. NGC/3593/[5743]/ Vishi-2, Dated 24.9.1993 states the criterion for student enrollment while sanctioning a new college. The directives are as follow:

The above letter also clarifies that the enrollment in rural area [Zilla Parishad region] at the graduate level should be minimum 24 and at the post-graduate level, it should be minimum 16. Besides the government letter No. NGC-2086/[335]/ Vishi-2(A) Dated 18/11/1987 states that if the population of the city is less than 50,000, then the criterion of minimum enrollment is relaxed to 10.

Government Decision

Though the government has given directives in the letter <u>mentioned</u> in the introduction, it is noticed that there is no uniformity in the university areas while granting division to non-government colleges and this is creating problem while sanctioning the grants. Besides, the financial burden is unnecessarily mounting. In such a situation (circumstances), the issue of deciding student enrollment criterion for non-government Arts, Commerce and Science colleges was under the government consideration.

2. The government hereby approves the enrollment numbers for the non-government Arts, Commerce and Science colleges in the state as follow.

3. In connection with the above rules, it is clarified that the number of enrollment decided for the first division, for example; for urban area the enrollment fixed for the first division is 60 to 100, and it will be applicable to Arts, Commerce and Science branches of learning. If the



number of enrollment is less than 60, then no division can be started, and if started it will not be eligible for the grants. And for opening second division the number of enrollment should be minimum 120. If the 120 enrollment is not there, the division will not be eligible for the grants.

- 4. The minimum number of enrollment for the graduate and the post-graduate subjects shall remain as notified earlier, 24 & 16 respectively. But for tribal colleges, for rural area colleges and for urban women colleges located in the area of population less than 50,000, the minimum enrollment should be 10.
- 5. The non-agricultural universities and non-government Arts, Commerce and Science colleges should take adequate precaution before starting/ submitting proposal for a new division. The above rules must be strictly followed.
- 6. The above rules will be applicable to non-grants/ permanent non-grants colleges for sanction of division. But the condition (non-grants/ permanent-grants) on which the college is sanctioned will be applicable for sanction of division.
- The decision in the present circular will be applicable from the academic year 1995-96.
